Minimum Entry Requirements: Grade C in GCSEs English, Maths & Science or equivalent. A first degree at classification 2:2 or above. NCTL Professional Skills Tests in Numeracy and Literacy. If following the School Direct Salaried route you will need to have 3 years full-time paid work experience. This does not have to be related to education.

The School Direct Route: A one year, full-time, school based route. You will be based in one school for the majority of the training programme but will also have a short placement in a second school to provide a contrasting experience. Trainees achieve QTS on successful completion of the course, with PGCE or 120 Masters Level 7 credits (optional for SD Salaried at an extra cost) Training is majority school-based with some centre-based training. Most of your professional studies training will be based at your host school and supplemented by training provided by Essex Teacher Training.
